## **Winter Park, Colorado, February 1–8, 2014,**

Winter Park Resort Colorado is our ski week destination in 2014.

Rotary Club President, Clark Lipscomb wrote,

Great skiing, a unique village, and three different locations for lodging all within walking distance to the lifts, a multitude of restaurants and a local Rotary Club totally committed to providing ISFR a fantastic week of skiing, fellowship and fun."*

Located just 67 miles from downtown Denver on the west side of the Continental Divide, Winter Park Resort offers over 3,000 acres of skiable terrain, 25 lifts, five terrain parks and a new slopeside village including lodging, restaurants and shops.

**Winter Park Resort** consists of four adjacent areas: Winter Park, Mary Jane, (including Parsenn Bowl), Vasquez Cirque, and Vasquez Ridge. A network of trails and chairlifts connects the four distinct mountains. ### **Average Annual Snowfall**

Winter Park Resort receives over 29 feet of snow annually, and has the most consistent snow season after season. Snowmaking is available on 26 trails covering 299 acres (121 hectares). The snowmaking capabilities guarantee the opening of Winter Park before Thanksgiving.

### **Terrain**

Elevation: at top 10,700, bottom 9,000; Trails: 3,081 total skiable acreage (1,246 hectares), includes 143 designated trails and 1,212 acres (490 hectares) of off-piste terrain; Longest run: 4.6 miles with a vertical drop of 3,060 feet.

## Chairlifts

25 lifts including The Village Cabriolet, two high-speed six-pack lifts, seven high-speed express quads, four triplets, six double chairlifts, three surface lifts, one platter and one rope tow. Uphill capacity of 40,000 riders per hour. The Zephyr Express is modified to accommodate 20 gondola cabins for dinner service to The Lodge at Sunspot.

Reduced rates are offered at three resort hotels within walking distance of each other and the lifts.

## **BAD KLEINKIRCHHEIM, AUSTRIA, January 18-25, 2014**



Bad Kleinkirchheim, a ski resort in the South of Austria, located close to the Italian and Slovenian border will host the 12th European Ski Week of the International Skiing Fellowship of Rotarians (ISFR) from January 18th -25th, 2014.

The first written document mentioning Bad Kleinkirchheim dates back to July 5th 1166. Eleven years later the town in Carinthia makes an appearance in a document written by Pope Alexander III that is today in the possession of the Public Record Office in Vienna. The municipality of Bad Kleinkirchheim was founded several centuries later in 1850. Bad Kleinkirchheim was granted the title 'Bad' – German for spa resort – in 1935. Ever since, your picturesque holiday resort in Carinthia has attracted holidaymakers from all over the world.

During your ski holiday in Carinthia at one of the stops on the World Cup circuit, you'll experience 100km of well-groomed ski pistes, 23 ski huts and 25 lifts that will carry you quickly and safely to where you want to go.

800 snow cannons cover 97 per cent of the slopes in the Nockberge Mountains – guaranteeing you perfect snow conditions for your skiing holiday in Bad Kleinkirchheim, Austria.

The Bad Kleinkirchheim ski region is the home of Olympic champion Franz Klammer. Twice during the ski season you can have the chance to ski with him on the slopes of Bad Kleinkirchheim. Fast-paced descents and focused tutoring – these are hallmarks of the Early Morning Skiing.

With the ski pass for Bad Kleinkirchheim-St Oswald you can do more than just ski: fun and activity offers such as "Nock-tubing" or tobogganing, are all included

in the price your pass. Also included are free rides with the ski-thermal-bus and free parking at the base of the ski lifts. <http://www.badkleinkirchheim.at/skiing-carinthia>.

The local Rotary Club Bad Kleinkirchheim in cooperation with all Rotary Clubs of Carinthia will host and organize this event. Program highlights include the opening ceremony, daily meeting point, dinner at home with Rotarian friends and music shows. The giant slalom, the cross-country race and the snowboard event are some of the most exiting events and will eventually determine the "2014 Rotary World Champion".
